The purpose of the additional safety is for individuals who may require special restraint and safety. The Federal Government has no guidelines on who can or who can not safely participate on an amusement devise that is physically challenged. Majestic Manufacturing can not be responsible for the safety of individuals that go beyond the limitation and guidelines set forth by Majestic.

- 1. All riders must understand the concept of the bumper cars (they bump into each other).
- 2. No rider should ride this ride with a physical condition that would become aggravated, accelerated or compounded in any way due to the bumping action.

This service bulletin is to all owner/operators with Majestic Bumper cars and rectifiers. Daily inspections are required on all electrical components and speed selection settings to insure safe operating conditions. Incoming electricity, outside elements, integrity of the floor, ceiling and cars all combine together and must produce a safe operation.

- 1. Recommended speed setting for floor ceiling type is three (3) on the rectifier or approximately 2 1/2 feet per second for adult cars.
- 2. Recommended speed setting for floor only type is one (1) to two (2) on the rectifier which will produce 2 feet per second for adult cars.
- 3. Recommended speed setting for all Mini bumper cars is 1 foot per second.
- 4. The higher the speed setting the greater the risk for an incident.
- 5. The owner/operator should exercise prudent judgement on who can and who cannot safely operate the bumper cars.

For additional information regarding the safe operation and maintenance of bumperscars, Majestic offers both training and maintenance procedures.

For longevity of new or used tires, tale the tires prior to each operation for the first month to insure that the tire operates with sufficient lubrication. Then each month thereafter, apply the tale 3 times per week.

Memorandum

RE: SEAT BELTS

Majestic Manufacturing, Inc. has established that the driver – operator on a full size adult bumper car must be a minimum of 48" in height.

Majestic Manufacturing, Inc. also has a height restriction of 42" to be a passenger in a full size bumper car vehicle.

All riders a minimum of 48" tall or taller may operate a full size adult car equipped with a factory supplied lap bar in factory operating condition without wearing the over the shoulder seat belt.

Any passengers with a height between 42" and 48" tall are to wear the over the shoulder belt as additional protection from injury. The loop style belt for these passengers should be worn with the belt under both armpits, not under one armpit and around the neck.

This memorandum supersedes any previous specification on seat belts and lap bar applications.

Notice: Seatbelts and speeds for Bumper Cars

This speed is for cars being operated in Omni: Directional Use

When a Majestic DC power supply is utilized to supply DC circuit to a Majestic Bumper Cars in a normal operating environment, the recommended speed setting is a #3 on the rectifier control tap switch (see Service Bulletin 96-8).

When this setting is utilized, a normal rate of speed in the bumper car is approximately 3'- 4' per second. Certain conditions such as; corrosion on the ceiling, corrosion on the floor, and / or poor contact of metal components in the bumper car, may require a higher rectifier setting to achieve a 3'- 4' per second approximate speed.

When the parameters are met and the bumper car is equipped with a factory lap bar in factory working condition, the use of supplemental seat belts is not required for drivers of the car meeting a minimum of 48" tall or passengers in the car no less than 42" tall.

It should also be noted, that because of the variable problems associated with corrosion and poor electrical contact within the bumper car, speeds of the cars need to be monitored closely and variations of higher than recommended speeds should be kept to or as close to factory set standards as possible.

Page 2 of 2 Service Bulletin 2002-1 Seat belts for bumper cars

This does not apply to all drivers or riders with regards to individuals that are physically challenged.

It is the responsibility of the operator to offer the physically challenged riders the use of the enhanced protection supplemental seat belt.

If the owner/operator has a higher speed setting than factory recommended standards, the owner /operator is doing so at their own risk.
